The Library is proud to welcome Celtic Guitarist Jerry Barlow! Barlow's repertoire incorporates favorite traditional Celtic pieces and his own compositions.

For centuries, Celtic melodies have been played primarily on the harp, flute, pennywhistle and fiddle. More recently, innovative guitarists have developed methods of playing this enchanting music utilizing alternate tunings and techniques.

The Indie Acoustic Project has selected the title song from Barlow's newest CD BRING DOWN THE STORM, as "one of the best songs of 2006". His music has been featured in documentaries and can be heard on National Public Radio stations.

Barlow will be playing at the Library on April 10th. Tickets are available at the Library now, \$12.50 per person or \$20.00 per couple.
